- 4. Dendrobium bigibbum intervarietal exhibits (White).
- 5. Dendrobium bigibbum intervarietal exhibits (Bicolour).

- 18. Any other Sarcanthinae hybrids.

- 20. Any other Epiphytic and Terrestrial genera hybrids.
- 21. First flowering *Dendrobium* hybrid seedling.
- 22. First flowering hybrid seedling all other seedlings.

#### **Australasian Classes:**

- 23. Dendrobium Section Rhizobium (Dockrillia) species.
- 24. Dendrobium Section Rhizobium (Dockrillia) hybrids.
- 25. Any other Australasian species.
- 26. Dendrobium Section Latouria hybrids (excluding any Spatulata influence).
- 27. Dendrobium Section Spatulata hybrids.
- 28. Any other Australasian hybrids.
- 29. First flowering Australasian seedling.

#### **Novice Classes:**

- 30. Novice Class Any Native Species (see condition 17).
- 31. Novice Class Any Native Hybrid (see condition 17).

#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. All sections cover Australian/Australasian orchids only. No exhibit is to be garnished by any other plant (eg: moss) other than that which is naturally occurring on the exhibit. No exotic plant or other material is to be present on the exhibit.
- 2. Entries of exhibits shall be free. Exhibits to be benched by 5:00pm on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> April 2022. Judging to commence by Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> at 9am.
- 3. All exhibits must be free of pests, diseases and viruses. Every plant must be labelled clearly.
- 4. All exhibits are expected to be owned and in the possession of the exhibitor for at least the preceding six (6) months.
- 5. Classes may be split, rearranged and removed at the Show Marshal's discretion. The staging of all plants, rejecting, organising and positioning is only at the direction of the Show Marshals. Once a plant is benched it comes under the control of the Show Marshal. The Show Marshals decisions are final and binding.
- 6. All growers who are financial members of ANOS Inc, ANOS Groups, and AOC affiliated societies are eligible to enter.
- 7. ANOS Inc judging standards apply. The judges' decision shall be final and binding.
- 8. **Grand Champion:** Shall be selected from all first prize winners.
- 9. **Reserve Champion:** Shall be selected from the remaining first prize winners and the exhibit placed second to the Grand Champion in its class.
- 10. **Champion Specimen:** Shall be selected from all exhibits at the discretion of the judges.
- 11. Class 7: "Section *Dendrocoryne"* includes *adae, aemulum, callitrophilum, falcorostrum, finniganense, fleckeri, gracilicaule, jonesii, moorei, tetragonum*
- 12. Class 8: "Section *Rhizobium"* includes *bowmannii*, *brevicaudum*, *calamiforme*, *cucumerinum*, *dolichophyllum*, *fairfaxii*, *linguiforme*, *mortii*, *pugioniforme*, *racemosum*, *rigidum*, *schoeninum*, *striolatum*, *teretifolium*, *wassellii*.
- 13. **Classes 11, 12, 21, 22 & 29:** Definition of a seedling A seedling shall mean a plant (being a whole clone undivided) flowering for the first time since being raised from seed. For exhibition purposes, seedlings shall retain their status of seedlings through the flowering season in which they are first exhibited at a show, meeting or award judging. (These classes are eligible for the Best seedling award).
- 14. No prizes shall be given if in the judges' opinion a prize is not warranted.
- 15. ANOS Inc Central Coast Group will not be responsible for any loss, damage or destruction to plants and no exhibitor or seller shall have any claim against the society but all reasonable care will be taken.
- 16. Exhibits must not be removed from benches before the termination of the show, except with the authority of the Show Marshals.
- 17. Novice Section is open to growers as per Condition six (6) above providing they are Novice growers in their Society.
- 18. Perpetual trophies that are awarded remain the property of ANOS Inc. Central Coast Group.
