

In My Bushhouse

After the wet comes the wind. So check your orchids and water when necessary. I have noticed that some dry out quicker than others and also some are slowing down, like me, with the onset of winter.

I will check and water now only every 10-14 days now but fertilizing with that.

This week I gave a last water with Carbaryl® To clean off any last bugs prior to winter / spring flowering.

I think that for me at least the flowering of all *Dendrobium speciosum* varieties this year will be a good one. Despite the lack of sunshine and the torrential rain at times this year it seems that at least one group the var *capricornicum* are in love with the conditions.

This group is different enough to have warranted varietal status, at least by some botanists. It has leaves not unlike var *pedunculatum* that will snap at the drop of a hat. Also they are very stiff and adapted to their dryer habitat. Imagine living your life on the top of a granite plug that must get to 50deg C in summer and no relief from the sun. Sadly most of these have been stripped from the wild in the late 1980-90's. Anyway if you were lucky to get your hands on one of these they flower from May to August when no other *Den speciosum* is out.

Flowering at the moment is *Den. speciosum* var. *capricornicum*, *Den. prenticei*, *Doc. Wamberal*, *Den. Hilda Poxon* and totally out of season is *Dockrillia calamiformis*.

Check your orchids and stake cans as necessary prior to the flowering season, don't wait until flowering as then it's too late and will look unnatural.

Benching Rules for ANOS Warringah Group

Open Growers

- o A member of ANOS Warringah Group, regardless of when he/she became a member, who is an "Open Member" of any ANOS or AOC affiliated Orchid Society must bench in the open class at the ANOS Warringah Group monthly meetings and shows.

Novice Growers

- o A Novice Grower is an orchid grower with limited experience in growing orchids.
- o A Novice Member of the ANOS Warringah Group is a Member who has not been elevated to the "Open" class of this Society and is not an "Open Member" of any other ANOS or AOC affiliated Orchid Society, for the purpose of benching orchids at monthly meetings or shows.

Benching Restriction

To bench an orchid/s for points the member must have owned and personally grown an orchid/s for 6 months prior to benching at the ANOS Warringah Group monthly meetings and shows.

Transition from 'Novice' to 'Open'

A Novice Member of ANOS Warringah Group will be elevated to "Open Member" for the purpose of benching orchids at monthly meetings and shows when;

- a) he/she wins a major prize(s) at the ANOS Warringah Group Spring Show and/ or St. Ives Orchid Show & Fair and consistently benches quality plants at the monthly meetings to the satisfaction of the Committee, or
- b) he/she wins the annual novice benching points score by a substantial margin and consistently benches quality plants at the monthly meetings to the satisfaction of the Committee, or
- c) he/she is elevated to an "Open Member" in another ANOS or AOC Affiliated Orchid Society for the purpose of benching orchids at monthly meetings or shows.
- d) he/she of their own will benches in the open section in any one year.

Benching Competition Points

Benching points are allocated as below, and count towards prizes at the end of the year.

1st = 3 points

2nd = 2 points

3rd = 1 point

Plus 1 benching point per plant up to a maximum of 2 points

i.e. if you benched 3 plants and received 1st, 2nd, and 3rd the maximum points received in 1 class would be 3+2+1+1+1=8 points




